

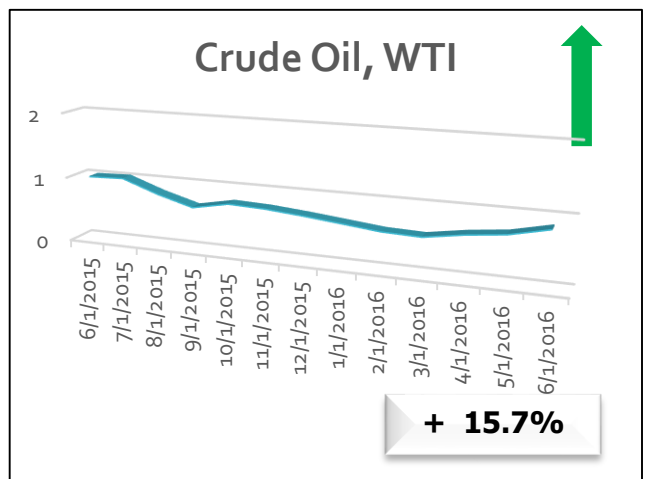
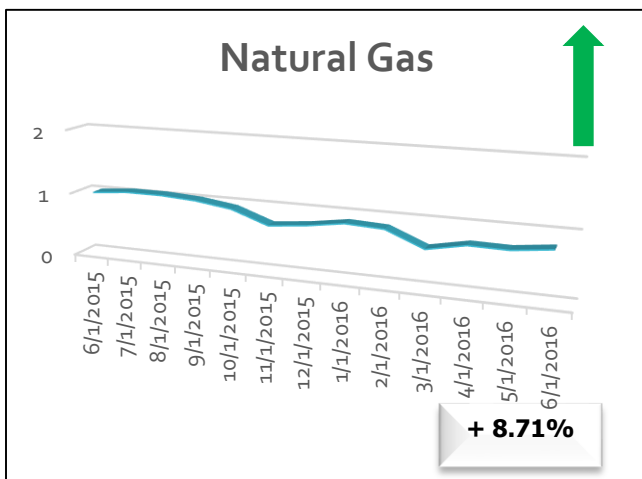

Commodity Trends:

- **Jobs Report:** The Bureau of Labor Statistics announced that employers added only 38,000 jobs last month, the smallest gain since September 2010. Meanwhile, the unemployment rate dropped to its lowest rate in nearly nine years, indicating that young people might be abandoning the labor force. These results were far off economists' expectations for about 155,000 jobs.
- **Retail Sales:** The Commerce Department said retail sales increased 0.5% last month after gaining 1.3% in April. Economists had been expecting growth to slow to 0.3% in May.
- **Manufacturing:** The Institute of Supply Management's manufacturing PMI index was 51.3, beating the expectation for a slump to 50.3. According to ISM, new orders and production continued to rise, but at a slower pace. Manufacturing employment shrank again at an unchanged pace, while the drop in inventories picked up speed.
- **U.S. Auto Sales:** In total, Americans purchased 1.54 million cars and light trucks last month in the U.S., according to data provider Autodata Corp., 6% fewer than a year earlier. The drop largely is due to two fewer selling days last month; sales were up modestly when adjusted for seasonal factors.
- **U.S. Home Sales:** Pending home sales, which are purchases that haven't closed yet, were up 4.6% in April compared with the same month a year earlier, according to the National Association of Realtors Pending Home Sales Index. This is the most homes under contract since February 2006, according to NAR.

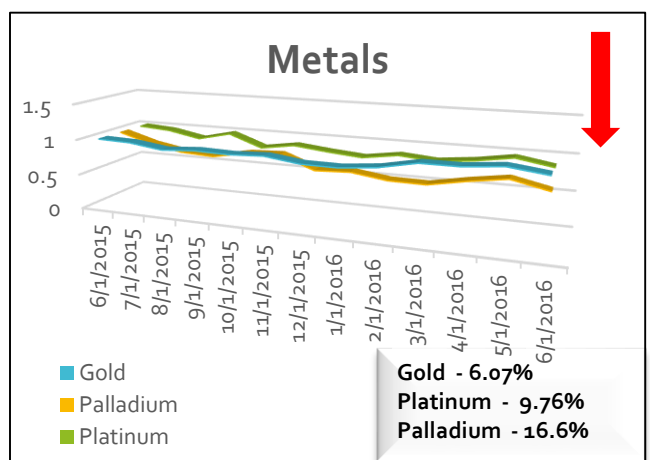
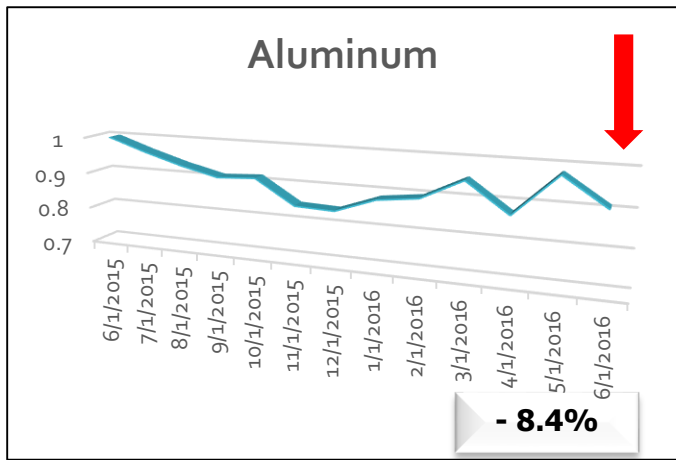
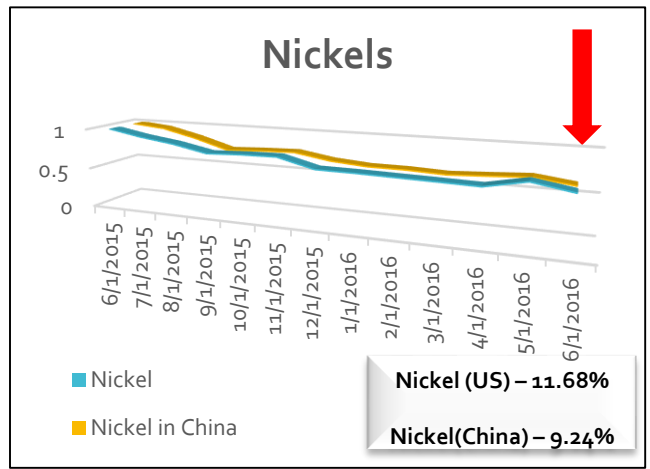
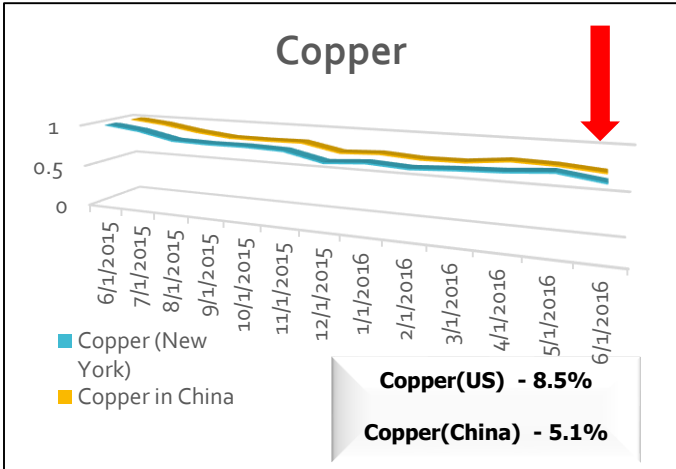
The graphs below represent a one year price trend for comparison only and do not reflect end user delivered prices. Additional 1-month trend percentages have been included on each commodity reported.

Petroleum Derivatives and Energy



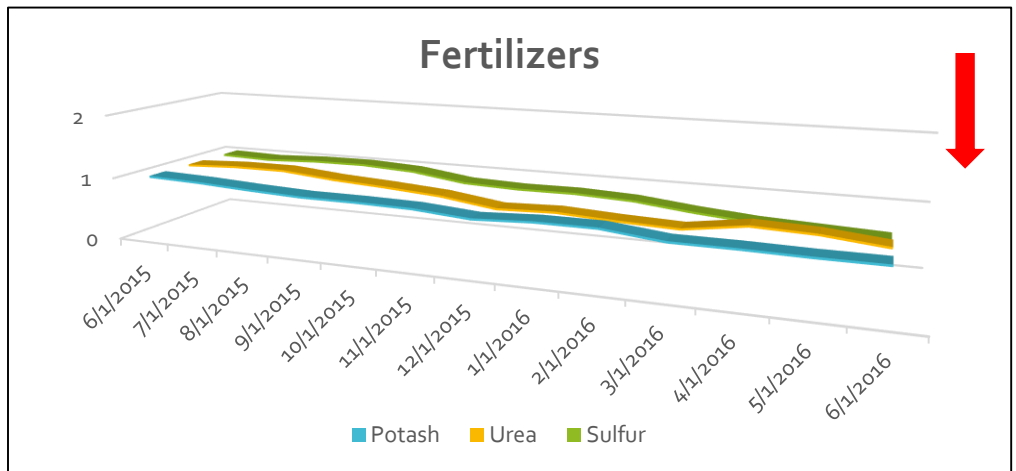
